#### **ORDINANCE NO. 995**

# AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTHFIELD, MINNESOTA DESIGNATING HERITAGE PRESERVATION SITES IN THE NORTHFIELD HISTORIC DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the City of Northfield (City) has a significant number of historic resources throughout the community; and

WHEREAS, the Northfield City Council has declared as matter of public policy that the preservation, protection, perpetuation, promotion and use of areas, places, buildings, structures, lands, districts and other objects having a special historical, community or aesthetic interest or value is a public necessity and is required in the interest of health, prosperity, safety and welfare in the community; and

WHEREAS, Northfield City Code, Chapter 34, Section 8.5.7, provides the process for the City, from time to time, determining that certain places, buildings, structures, properties, or district areas or properties within the community are of significance in American history, architecture, archeology, engineering, landscaping, and culture and those locations should be subject to additional review as it relates to the LDC; and

WHEREAS, based upon historic survey work and a final report prepared by Landscape Research in 2016, the Heritage Preservation Commission (HPC) is proposing the City add four properties located at 515 Division Street South, 517 Division Street South, 519 Division Street South, and 107 3rd Street West (collectively the "designated properties"), to the Northfield Historic District (District) by locally designating such properties as Heritage Preservation Sites; and

WHEREAS, the designated properties are shown on the map attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A, and more particularly described and identified as listed on Exhibit B, which is also attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the survey work and report followed guidelines established by the Secretary of the Interior for preservation planning and the Guidelines for History/Architecture Projects in Minnesota provided by the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) as well as the governing state statute and above-referenced City Code criteria; and

WHEREAS, the survey work completed by the consultant consisted of researching the history of each identified building, photography, evaluation of historic significance, and completion of a new inventory form; and

WHEREAS, the survey was completed in July, 2016 and submitted to SHPO, and SHPO has accepted the report and its recommendations for designating the designated properties as Heritage Preservation Sites in the District; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission reviewed the HPC proposal at its May 2017 meeting and has also recommended approval by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the official public hearing for this ordinance per the published notice announcing amendments to the District was held before the City Council on June 6, 2017; and

WHEREAS, upon request by the City Council, an informational presentation providing additional details on the District was provided on October 10, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the designated properties have historic and architectural significance and adopts as its findings the analysis of the designated properties as contained in the City staff report, dated January 16, 2018, and the final report submitted by Landscape Research.

### THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHFIELD DOES ORDAIN THAT:

Section 1. The designated properties located at 515 Division Street South, 517 Division Street South, 519 Division Street South, and 107 3<sup>rd</sup> Street West as depicted in Exhibit A and more particularly described as listed on Exhibit B are hereby designated as Heritage Preservation Sites in the Northfield Historic District and the boundary thereof shall be adjusted accordingly.

Section 2. The recitals hereto are made a part hereof.


Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty days after its publication.
