Update Arts Cohort – March 2018

The Arts Cohort has completed the process of carefully gleaning through Arts Plan '06. We have identified the continued progress of certain reachable goals, removed completed objectives and identified ongoing tasks for the Arts and Culture Commission that still exist in the 12-year old plan. We are now ready to begin the process of creating an easily readable and well-designed arts and culture plan with this information and new goals that we know are existing on the horizon yet. We plan to align the plan with the City's Strategic Plan, so that the Arts and Culture Plan can be approved and successful as a tool for the future.
