2. <u>18-183</u> Presentation on 501, 503, & 505 Division Street South Renovation Project

Dave Medin, Brett Reese, Chad Jenkinson, Joshua Drivdahl and Chris Knelley presented plans for the renovation of 501, 503, & 505 Division Street and updated the commission

on the progress so far. Specific design topics discussed included:

- Color of clading on windows
- Interior and exterior signage projecting sign and gold lettering on glass
- Exterior lighting

The HPC suggested black clad windows for the main entrance and grey for the others. They approved of a perpendicular sign and gold lettering on the glass. They would like more information on the lighting proposal and other changes to the facade prior to approval of a Certificate of Appropriateness.

3. 18-184 NDDC Discussion

Jenni Roney, Executive Director of the Northfield Downtown Development Corporation was present to discuss collaborative opportunities with the HPC.

Outreach to businesses related to signage revisions, streetlighting, CLG grants, and the Mainstreet Program were areas where collabaorative efforts could occur.

The HPC also voiced concern related to the substantial tax increases to downtown businesses.

Jenni noted the NDDC meets the fourth Monday of each month at 4:00 p.m. at their new location at 19 Bridge Square.

4. 18-185 Sign Permit for Armory, 519 Division

The HPC reviewed the sign proposal for the Armory at 519 Division Street. Staff noted a monument sign could be allowed at this site since the property has not been officially amended into the Historic District.

The HPC felt the font on the sign should be revised to match the existing sign on the building. J. Bohnhoff stated he would be able to make this change. The commission also voiced concern related to the words taking up more than 60% of the space.

A motion was made by Board Member Clark, seconded by Board Member Mohring, to approve the sign permit on the condition that the font on the sign, specifically "armory square", is made to match the existing font on the armory building cornice. The motion carried by the following vote:
