Stormwater Pollution is becoming a problem because anything left in your street is likely to make it into a river (or other body of water) near you, but there are things you can do to help.



Trash from your street can end up in your river, but you can help by taking a trash walk around your street and picking up all the trash you can find.

Don't use fertilizer on your lawn because the fertilizer can wash into the river and a chemical in most fertilizer called phosphorus makes big green algae and a lot of less fish.

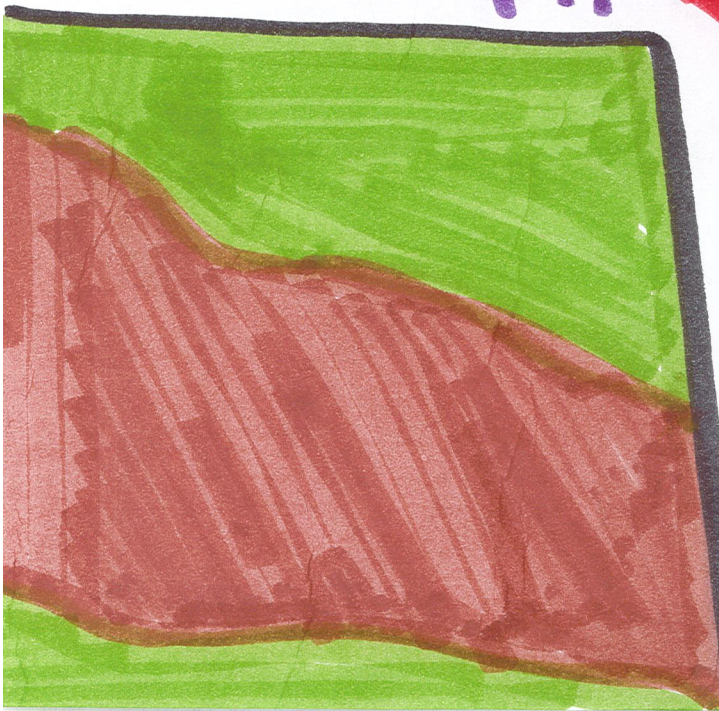

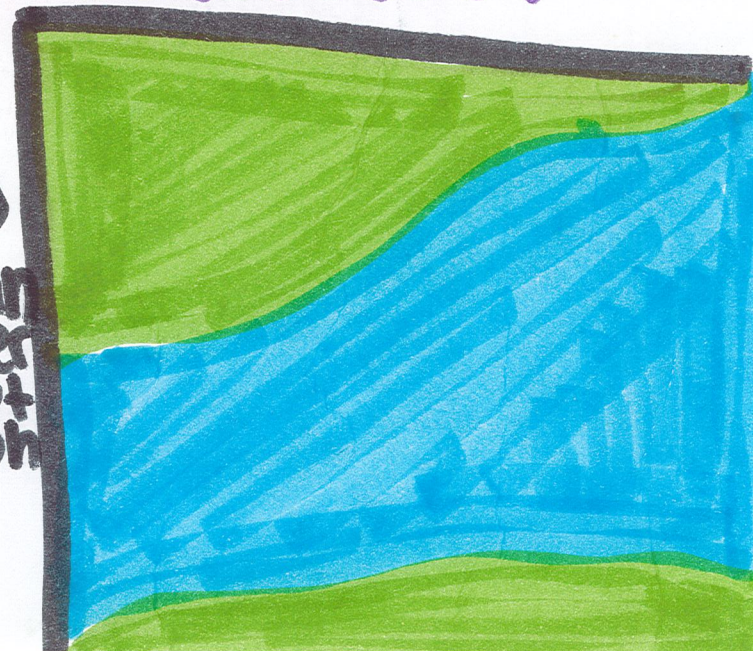
