Walking Trails

- Most City trails have been swept
- East Cannon River & Babcock trails
 - Were briefly closed due to flooding

Sechler Park 1st National Field rebuild

- The scope of the project rebuilding the pitcher's mound, home plate area & pitcher warm up areas by the MN Parks & Turf Association
- Staff met recently with MN Parks & Turf representatives to develop an action plan

• Sechler & Babcock Parks

- o Softball & baseball activates are underway.
- o Field improvements continue daily
- Two new batting cage nets have been installed
- o Lacrosse being played at two location
 - Sechler Park
 - Sibley Soccer fields
 - · Had new nets installed
- Babcock Park rodeo bleachers
 - Randolph FFA will remove when family crops are planted
 - New bleacher install will get underway after removal
- Neighborhood baseball fields are operational
 - Three fields
 - Roosevelt Park
 - Washington Park
 - Way Park

Spring Native Planting Areas:

- Spring burning of certain parks will happen when weather allows.
 - Currently Oddfellows & Lashbrook Parks are being planned

Recent Spring growth might hinder burning operations.

• Bridge Square:

- Fountain will be operational soon
- o Thanks to the Garden Club for the recent addition of flowers to the square
- o Six new flower planters have been added to the East River Commons area
 - Funded by the Garden Club
- Downtown flower baskets
 - June 1 planned install.

Riverside Park:

- The third & final raised planting bed has been installed
 - The planter is in the shape of a Honey Bee

Park Mowing & Cleanup:

- Seasonal Mowing staff start May 14
 - Take 3+ days to mow City park areas
- Seasonal staff start May 14
 - Cleanup started
 - Seasonal staff allow cleanup to be completed in a timely manner
- Spring vandalism
 - Staff dealt with several recent acts of vandalism
