## Tasting at the Defeat of Jesse James Days Rodeo event

In 2012, Defeat of Jesse James Days Committee, Inc. ("DJJD," "Committee" or "Licensee") was allowed to have a whiskey tasting at the DJJD Rodeo Entertainment Center. The event was well received, and according to the Northfield Police, DJJD committee members and attendees, was well controlled and organized. DJJD would like to have the whiskey tasting at the 2018 Rodeo Entertainment Center. Pursuant to Paragraph 18 of the Agreement and subject to the Agreement and all liquor licensing requirements under law and the Agreement, Licensee is permitted to hold a whiskey tasting event in accordance with the below rules. The below rules applicable to the whiskey tasting event are in addition to those that are otherwise required by law, the Community Events Policy, and the Agreement):

- Only DJJD committee officials will pour the tasting products at the tasting event within the designated tasting area as depicted in the below site map
- A list of the Committee officials authorized to pour products at the tasting event shall be provided to the Chief of Police
- Committee officials will obtain training to ensure that no person participating in the tasting event gets over served and over consumes products provided at the tasting event
- Extra security will be provided by DJJD for the tasting area identified in the below site map during all tasting hours, to ensure no person will be over served and over consumes products provided at the tasting event
- Additional fencing is required for the tasting area. The extra fencing shall be a minimum of 4' in height and be approved by the Chief of Police or designee. It will be attached to the beer pouring area for security.
- There shall be only one entrance for the public to enter and exit the tasting area, but emergency exists shall be provided as required by law as approved by the Chief of Police or designee.
- Tasting at the tasting area will include all items already offered at the Rodeo Site Entertainment Center, including Beer, Wine and up to two intoxicating liquor (hard liquor) items.
- There will be a 3 drink maximum per person on all products provided in the tasting area
- Special wrist bands or hand stamps will track and limit consumption to the maximum allowed for each person in the tasting area
- The tasting products must be consumed within the rodeo grounds entertainment center only
- Up to two intoxicating liquor (hard liquor) items and related products for the tasting will only be offered in the tasting area. All others products will be offered in other properly licensed areas
- The tasting area shall be that area shown on the following map depiction:
