Arts & Culture Recognitions

Hardy: About 120 people attended the poetry reading by Danez Smith, which is possibly a record. Thank you to Debby Nitz for her efforts in promoting the event.

Flom: Thank you to everyone who sent in videos of themselves reading poetry for Poem in Your Pocket Day.

Lawrenz: The Northfield Experience was incredible, a shout-out to everyone involved. Every performance was completely full.

Flom: Particularly enjoyed getting to watch the final performance at the library with Koplowitz, and kudos to Alice Thomas for smoothing out the area by the Depot for the dancers.

Ewald: Exhibiting at FiftyNorth Gallery from May 14 - June 14. Opening reception May 22, 4-6pm.

Lawrenz: The Honors Art Show is up. Opening reception May 18, 7-9pm with artist talks at 7:30pm.

Melby: Both Carleton and St. Olaf currently have Senior Art shows up. The Northfield Youth Choir had a performance at which Cully Hauck and Danny Allin were honored.

Hauck: 39 Steps was performed at the high school. It was a great play and Danny Allin performed in it.

Allin: The Northfield Swing Dance was a big success.

Lawrenz: The Latino Play Festival started last weekend.

Melby: A group of St. Olaf students is working on getting open captioning at the movie theater for one age-restricted and one family-friendly show per month. The Empty Bowls fundraiser at Carleton raised over \$8,000. The Cinco de Mayo festival last week was a big success.

Draft Cultural Plan -- comments & feedback

The group provided feedback on the draft plan. Hauck thanked Melby for her leadership on the subcommittee and let the ACC know that her amazing leadership skills really helped move the project forward. Hauck expressed particular appreciation for Jensen's knowledge of existing city plans. **ACTION: Melby will contact Mayor Pownell about sending a thank-you letter on city letterhead to each of the Cohort participants.**

The PARC for 7th & Division project will consist of Ewald, Hauck, and city staff yet to be named. Perhaps also someone from a business near the intersection. **ACTION: PARC will draft a Call for Proposals for sculpture at 7th & Division, and this will become a template for future CFPs.** Goal is to get the CFP out in June or July. Anticipate needing to convene a PARC for Highway 3 & Third Street sculpture pads, and also Ames Park Gateway enhancements.
