SIGNED DSI Refuse Contract

The residential refuse collection contract between DSI and the City of Northfield expires on March 31, 2019. DSI representatives were present to answer questions from EQC members, discus "wishcylcing" as well as realistic ways to improve service. Following a lengthy discussion, three areas were noted as priority areas to address when considering renewing the DSI contract in 2019. Those areas were:

- 1. improve recycling education to reduce contamination (stickers, mobile education center)
- 2. receive waste stream data on an annual basis
- 3. organic curb side composting

Staff will draft a recommendation to be reviewed and approved by EQC in July to be presented to council in August.

**3.** <u>18-309</u> Discussion of Urban Forest Management Policy

The Urban Forest Management Policy from 2014 was revisited. After review, several of
