Staff updated the board on the CDBG Quarterly Report and explained why the \$12,881.23

in pre-2015 CDBG funds were unused and recaptured by HUD.

4. <u>HRA M2018-003</u> Community Development Block Grants-Activity Amendment

Staff reported they are unable to find additional funding for the Greenvale Sidewalk Project which are required for the project to move forward. She recommended that the \$20,090 be reallocated to the Northern Oaks Rehabilitation Project.

Staff also reported the Northfield Union of Youth will not be eligible to receive CDBG funds since their program has already started. HUD rules state that funds cannot be used for existing public service projects. She asked that the \$9,000 allocated for this program also be reallocated to the Northern Oaks Rehabilitation Project.

Leah Hall, Three Rivers Community Action, explained to the board that the original Northern Oaks Rehabilitation plan had been decreased due to available funds. With additional funds they could expand the rehabilitation project to include other needed repairs.

The HRA discussed the importance of the Greenvale Sidewalk Project and the Union of Youth Homeless Prevention program.

A motion was made by Board Member Nystrom, seconded by Board Member Zweifel, to submit a CDBG activity amendment to the CDA for the transfer of \$20,090 from Public Facilities-ADA sidewalk and \$9,000 from Youth Homeless Prevention programs to the Northern Oaks Rehabilitation project. The motion carried by the following vote:

A motion was made by Board Member Fink and seconded by Board Member Nystrom to commit up to \$20,090 of HRA operating funds to the Greenvale Sidewalk Project pending the ability to obtain additional funding and also provide \$9,000 from the operating fund to the Northfield Union of Youth for the Youth Homeless Prevention Program. The motion carried by the following vote:
