| Earth Day | Division Str. between 5th & 6th Str. and Armory Square | 4/21/2018 | 3/6/2018 | \$300 | The Earth Day organizers are planning for food trucks, music, and activities on Division Str. between 5th & 6th Str. During the time of the street closure, there will be activity in Armory Square with exhibitors, a keynote speaker, followed by a community forum. Division Street between 5th & 6th is proposed to be closed from 2 pm - 8 pm. Expected attendance is 400. |
| Run/Walk for Child Abuse Prevention | Sechler Park | 4/28/2018 | 3/6/2018 | None requested | The Center for Family Unity is sponsoring a 5K run/walk to help prevent child abuse. The event will be used to help raise funds for their work in Rice, Steele, and other nearby counties. Expected attendance is 300. |
| The Northfield Experience/St. Olaf College, Carleton College, Arts & Culture Commission and Stephan Koplowitz | See description. | 5/3-6/2018 | 3/6/2018 | \$600 | The Northfield Experience at take place at eight Northfield locations, May 4-6, 2018, with a dress rehearsal on May 3. Locations will be: The Grand Theater (interior); The Northfield Public Library (interior and exterior); The Train Depot (exterior); Northfield Historical Museum (interior); Hvistendahl Law Office (interior); NAG Theater on East Third (interior); downtown NAG art gallery (interior); and The Northfield Cemetery. Performances of theater/dance/visual art/digital media will occur simultaneously at each site and spectators will travel on foot and by bus between sites. These performances will repeat multiple times between 6 and 9 pm, Thursday through Sunday; and between 2-5 pm on Saturday and Sunday. During the last 20 minutes of each event period, all spectators (@300 per performance) will be bused to The Northfield Cemetery to witness a dance/choral performance on the cemetery grounds. Approximately 150 singers and dancers will perform. Spectators will view the performance from the center road. The Northfield Experience highlights Northfield's history, architecture, and current social concerns. The aim is to reach a broad spectrum of Northfield residents, as well as draw visitors from southern MN and the Twin Cities. Public property impacted will be: Exterior corner of Grand Event Center (event check-n hub); interior and exterior of Northfield Public Library; exterior of Northfield Train Depot; Bridge Square near Northfield Historical Museum and Hvistendahl Law Office; exterior sidewalks leading to Northfield Arts Guild Theater (W. Third St.) and Northfield Arts Guild downtown art gallery; and The Northfield Cemetery. |

The market will feature local fine arts, crafts, cut flowers, local produce, artisan foods and other products as well as entertainment. Expected attendance is 300-500/day. |
| First Friday Art Nights/NDDC | Bridge Square and a few street corners in the C1 District | 6/7 - 12/7/2018 | 3/6/2018 | \$120 | Every first Friday of the Month (except DJJD) from 5-9 pm art and performances of all kinds will take place in Downtown Northfield, including dance, theater, visual arts, vocal and instrumental music, poetry, film, improv and more. Art experiences will occur inside businesses and outside in public spaces as weather allows. The events will take place on Bridge Square and on a few street corners in the C1 District. Expected attendance is 200. |

| Community Band Bridge Square | Bridge Square and street between the Post Office and Northfield Historical Society. | 6/7, 14, 21 & 28/2018 | 3/6/2018 | \$550 | The Northfield Community Band hosts a free concert series every summer where families and community members can enjoy music in Bridge Square. All band members are volunteers. Expected attendance 50+. |
| Theater in The Park – Northfield Arts Guild | Central Park | 6/9 - 30, 2018 | 3/6/2018 | \$120 | The Northfield Arts Guild will present the annual Theater-in-the-park production in Central Park. The event will take place June 9-10 (stage construction), June 11-21 (rehearsals) and June 22-24 & 28-30 (performances) Expected attendance 50-100 for performances. |

Participants will purchase tickets, walk through downtown Northfield and spend their tickets on food and drinks at participating establishments. Expected attendance - 300. | Y Kids Triathlon – YMCA | Memorial Park & surrounding area | 6/23/2018 | 3/6/2018 | \$450 | The Y Kids Tri is a triathlon for kids ages 6-14 from Northfield and the surrounding communities. In the past, there has been 20% attendance from out of town, including many participants from Rochester, Owatonna, and the metro area. It is organized in collaboration with the Northfield Area Family YMCA and many community volunteers. This event was started in 2009 and has seen new families participate each year along with new families eager to participate once their children reach age 6. The Y Kids Tri is a swim, bike, run event. The participants swim at the outdoor pool, followed by a bike ride on surrounding neighborhood streets and then complete the run in the field and paths adjacent to the pool. The event begins at 8:30 am and will be completed by 10:30am on Saturday June 23rd. Expected attendance is 150 participants and 300+ spectators. |

Riders will be camping at Bridgewater Elementary or staying at local lodging properties. Shuttles will be provided so riders can experience our historic downtown. Riders will be on their own for the afternoon and evening to shop, dine and experience downtown. There are two bank raid re-enactments planned for attendees of both Bike MS and Carleton College Staff conference to watch. Expected attendance - 500. |
