

- Full Depth Pavement Reclamation (9"-12" Depth)
- Concrete Curb and Gutter Spot Repairs
- Sidewalk Spot Repairs & New Sidewalk Installations
- ADA Upgrades to Existing Pedestrian Ramps
- Railroad Crossing Improvements
- Storm Sewer & Sanitary Sewer Adjustments
- Watermain Improvements


Existing Pavement/Curb/Sidewalk Condition


- Transverse Cracking

Street Improvements

- Reclaim 9"-12" of Existing Base and Pavement
- Place 4" New Bituminous Pavement
- Railroad Crossing Improvements on Third Street (approx. 300 feet west of TH 3)
- Proposed On-Street Bike Lane Routes Included in the City's Bike & Trail Master Plan:
 - Fourth Street
 - Orchard Street
 - Armstrong Road/Forest Avenue
 - Lockwood Drive





Sidewalk Installations

 Zanmiller Drive (from Meldahl Lane to Gill Lane) – Safe Routes to School

- Third Street (from the Union Pacific railroad tracks to 200' west of Odd Fellow Lane) – MSAS Route
- Fourth Street (from Poplar Street to Oddfellows Lane)
- Plum Street (from Third Street to Fifth Street) TH 19
- Orchard Street (from Third Street to Fifth Street)
- Forest Avenue/Armstrong Road (from Lincoln Street to Fifth Street) – MSAS Route – TH 19

Sidewalk Installations Analyzed But Not Recommended

• Plum Street and Orchard Street

• Fourth Street to Fifth Street

- Complete Streets Policy:
 - 1. Accommodations for all users of the surface transportation network shall be balanced in accordance with the latest and best "complete streets" standards, principles, policies, and guidelines, **except** under one (1) or more of the following conditions:
 - a. Where the cost of providing such accommodations would be disproportionate given the need or probability of use, or
 - b. Where severe topographic or natural resource constraints prohibit such accommodations, or
 - c. Where conditions or restrictions outside the purview of the City of Northfield prohibit such actions.

In cases where one or more of these conditions occur, the City Administrator and professional staff will evaluate the project and make a recommendation to the City Council for their decision.

Utility Improvements

- Adjusting Storm Sewer & Sanitary Sewer Castings
- Rehab Strom Sewer Catch Basins & Manholes
- Strom Sewer Structure Replacement & Addition
- Gate Valve Box Adjustments
- Increase Size of Watermain consistent with Supply and Distribution Plan:
 - Orchard Street (Fourth St to Fifth St)
 - Fourth Street (Orchard St to Plum St)
 - Third Street (Odd Fellows Ln to Orchard St)
- Installation of Watermain on Plum Street (Fourth St to Fifth St)
- Replace Water Service Lines (to Property Line) in Areas of Watermain Improvements
