# NORTHFIELD MAYOR'S TASK FORCE ON YOUTH ALCOHOL & DRUG USE



Now Northfield ASAP - a formal city commission

- Take It To The Box has collected more than 23,000 pounds of unwanted medication since its inception
- Tip 411 launched
- Supported 39 Northfield Night to Unite parties last year, up from 21 the previous year
- Stalls Campaign: Participation by over **35** local businesses



#### **YOUTHBANK**



**\$89,261** in grants awarded since 2015 to 30 different Northfield youth-led projects ~ FIRST YouthBank chapter in the U.S. that awarded grants ~







#### **INTERNSHIPS**

**91** student internships since 2015

City summer internship program launched

**CNA training program** established with Northfield Retirement Community (55 youth trained between 2015-18)



**Presented over a dozen times on the Youth First model** (including recently at the League of Minnesota Cities Annual Conference)

# **Expected Results for 2019-21**

#### **CONTINUED YOUTH ON BOARDS**

Average of at least 22 boards/commissions per year

- ~ Continue to grow the diversity of the program
- ~ Deepen relationships with adults working with youth on boards



#### **YOUTHBANK**

Award \$50,000 in grants for youth-led projects through YouthBank



#### **CAREER PATHWAYS**

Launch of

option in Northfield



Establish Education Fellows Pilot for those interested in education career



Substance Abuse Prevention





Over next 3 years, explore law enforcement and/or municipal careers pathways

## CONTINUED STAFFING SUPPORT FOR NORTHFIELD

- Now includes a joint focus on chemical & mental health
- Expand local capacity for medication-assisted treatment for Opioid Use Disorder by 100%
- Provide the option for a local diversion class in Rice County for youth who are first-time tobacco, alcohol, or marijuana offenders
- Work with local partners to create a local youth recovery community
