The commission reviewed the sign regulations and discussed comments made by Board Member Thomas.

The following revisions were made:

- Delete Item 8a under Sign Types: Hanging or Suspended Signs. These are signs that are either hung or suspended from a ceiling or other structure.

- Add the following language under Lettering: Projecting signs may utilize a font other than serif.

- Add the following language under Sign Shape: Projecting signs may be fabricated in a variety of shapes appropriate to the building or business.

- Add the following language under Message: Telephone numbers and websites may be included, provided they are clearly secondary to the primary message of the sign and occupy no more than 20 percent of the total sign area allotted to lettering.

The HPC approved of the revisions and asked staff to incorporate them into a draft document for review at the January 2019 meeting. Staff noted it would be beneficial to invite business owners to this meeting. The public hearing held by the Planning Commission would also be another opportunity for public input.
