- **Babcock Park**
 - The hockey rink has ice
 - Frequent usage and compliments
 - Motion sensors were removed for lighting to promote a 'we're open' feel
- **Bridge Square**
 - Christmas/Holiday lights were removed mid-January
 - Several trees were pruned
- **John North Park**
 - Select trees were pruned
- **Washington Park/City Hall**
 - Pleasure rink is skate ready and has daily users when not covered with snow
 - Select trees were pruned
- **Spring Creek Soccer Complex**
 - Select trees were pruned
- **Jefferson Park**
 - Pleasure rink is skate ready and has daily users when not covered with snow
- **Greenvale Elementary School**
 - Pleasure rink is skate ready and has daily users when not covered with snow
- **Ice Arena Outside Rink**
 - Hockey rink has good ice
 - Hockey teams have been practicing on this sheet of ice
 - Recreational users also use the ice
 - Continued vandalism occurs at the warming house
- **Compost Site**
 - Snow from Downtown is being transported here
