Northfield Planned Walking and Bicycling Network map

General Cartographic Edits

- Zoomed out to show broader area
- Changed sidewalk color from gray to black
- Changed City border from black to gray
- Reduce the font size of street labels
- Added ponds and waterways
- Added school labels
- Added park labels
- Changed Mill Towns State Trail Route to a darker green
- Reduced opacity of 'Natural Greenway Corridors'

Specific Planned Network Edits

- Connected Thye Parkway to the Greenway to the north
- Removed all nature trails
- Inserted on-street bikeway on Dresden Avenue
- Inserted on street bikeway along Linden Drive and Lockwood Street
- Changed planned trails on 3rd Street, Lincoln Street, and Lincoln Parkway to planned on-street bikeways
- Inserted existing on-street bikeway on Jefferson Rd between Riverview Drive and Jefferson Pkwy
- Added planned bikeway between Honeylocust Drive and Heritage Drive
- Changed existing bikeway to planned near Honeylocust Drive
- Changed planned trail to existing in southwestern edge of city
- Added planned trails between Carter Drive and southern edge of city
- Added planned trail near Ford Street
- Remove planned sidewalks along Archibald Circle
- Added planned trail on east side of Division Street near High school. Connects to an on-street bikeway north of high school up to Woodley.
- Added sidewalk near Sibley Drive
- Removed on-street bikeway along Division north of Woodley
- Added trails near Highway 19 that connect to parking lot near greenway corridor

Street Type Table Update

- Identified street types that may present opportunities for implementing separated bicycle lanes
- Updated "candidate streets" for 'Parkway'
- Added clarification to 'Street' regarding the application of bicycle boulevards
- Added clarification on parking provision on 'Streets'
