**Summary Report:** Projects completed by the Street & Park Dept.

- **Babcock Park**
  - The park is operational
    - Dumpster and garbage cans are in place
    - Ballfield is on a mowing and striping rotation
    - Teams are practicing and games are being played
    - Rodeo Grounds were hydro seeded
- **Compost Site**
  - Compost is operational and receiving heavy use
  - We are still waiting for Mystic to screen soil pile
- **Bridge Square**
  - The fountain is running
  - The garden club has planted flowers
  - Seasonal events began 5/11
- **Sechler Park**
  - The park is operational
    - Dumpster and garbage cans are in place
    - Ballfields are on a mowing and striping rotation
    - Teams are practicing and games being played
    - Two additional Lacrosse fields will be added (temp.)
  - Staff are considering a designated ballfield mower
- **Riverside Park**
  - The park is operational
  - Seasonal events began 5/11
- **Meadowview Park**
  - Community gardens have been rototilled
  - 21 garden plots have been reserved
  - We will be adding an additional water tank

- **Bigger Picture**

- Seasonal staff for mowing started 5/13
- Mowing routes have started rotation
- Flower baskets are anticipated 5/22
- 55 trees were sold during the shade tree sale
- 200+ volunteers are expected for 'Love Our City' day 5/18
