Babcock Park

The park is operational

- Dumpster and garbage cans are in place
- Ballfield is on a mowing and striping rotation
- Teams are practicing and games are being played
- Rodeo Grounds is on a mowing rotation

Compost Site

- Compost is operational and receiving heavy use
- Soil pile has been screened and the dirt is exceptional

Sechler Park

- The park is operational
 - Dumpster an garbage cans are in place
 - Ballfields are on a mowing and striping rotation
 - Teams are practicing and games being played
 - Two additional Lacrosse fields have been added (temp.)
- The Almanzo bike event was partially held here 5/17-5/19; tents and RV's were allowed for the event, mostly rained out
- Staff have selected a new mower, the mower will be ordered the week of 6/17

Bigger Picture

- Seasonal staff have all started! We ended up short one mower staff
- Mowing routes are on a schedule, weather permiting
- Flower baskets are up and being watered
- The 'Love Our City' volunteer event was shifted into 3 separate smaller events due to rain
 - Tree planting was a success
 - Snowflakes, warming houses, and barricades were painted
 - 560 bags of mulch was placed over five needed areas
- Park staff do many other things in addition to park maintenance, like help at accidents
