



AARP AGE-FRIENDLY COMMUNITY INITIATIVE:

The City of Northfield became part of the World Health Organization (WHO/AARP Network of Age-friendly Communities in August of 2016. Age-Friendly Northfield's grassroots group is following a five-year process to take steps to become a better place to grow older. In keeping with this framework, the AFN Steering Committee led a community engagement process to identify what Northfield is doing well for older adults, and what areas need improvement. A survey for residents age 50-plus was supplemented with input from professionals in various sectors and additional community members. Survey data and findings from the listening sessions were analyzed and then translated into goals and priorities aimed at addressing what was learned.

The action plan is now complete and will be implemented from 2020-2022. This plan is about the work that still needs to be done to assure that Northfield is a good place to grow old.

The action plan's highest priority project is to meet the identified need for a centrally located comprehensive, coordinated information and referral system for senior services.

The AFN Steering Committee is requesting funding support for a Community Outreach Coordinator to accomplish this priority. In mid-October a Community Outreach Coordinator was hired by FiftyNorth in collaboration with Age-friendly Northfield. This is a dual position to support both the City of Northfield Age-friendly initiative and FiftyNorth's older adult outreach.

JOB POSITION SUMMARY:

- Develop the web-based information and referral system within the FiftyNorth website:
 Accurate, up-to-date information including contacts, descriptions of services and links to sites often
 accessed by older adults, their families, caregivers and professionals when seeking help including, but not
 limited to health and medical needs, city services, public library information, county health and social
 services, recreation, nutrition and transportation. Available in English/Spanish.
 Resources available in Spanish/English in print form.
- Provide 1:1 information: in-person help during office hours
- The Outreach Coordinator will go beyond being a generalist providing information and referral, will engage in aging issues and needs in the Northfield area
- Will cultivate partnerships with organizations, businesses, and individuals that provide older adult supports and services within the community to assure information is current
- · Form a network of providers as participating members of the Community Information Website
- · Keep information current and flowing; will share what organizations are doing
- Identify gaps in supports and services within the community and share that information with
 organizations that have an interest and capacity to fill the gaps. The result will be to breakdown silos that
 each organization work within; and discover ways for organizations to work together, and strengthen
 partnerships

NOTE: Age-friendly Northfield steering committee assessed FiftyNorth as the best location for the Outreach Coordinator as well as FiftyNorth website hosting the community resources. Our community survey found 75% of older adults would seek information at FiftyNorth. FiftyNorth has over 2,000 members.
