- Ward 3, Precinct 2 Bethel Lutheran Church, 1321 North Avenue
- Ward 4, Precinct 1 St. John's Lutheran Church, 500 Third Street W.
- Ward 4, Precinct 2 St. Olaf College Buntrock Commons, 1520 St. Olaf Avenue
