- HRA assists 1st time homebuyers with down payment, utilizing CDBG funds
- <u>Manufactured Home Rehab Program</u>
 - HRA assists income qualified MH homeowners with rehab costs, utilizing CDBG funds
- Northern Oaks Rehab Project
 - HRA assist with rehab costs for low and very low income residents, utilizing CDBG funds

- <u>CAC for homeless prevention program</u>
 HRA provides 2 dwelling units for program
- <u>Ruth's House of Hope for Women in Transition</u>
 <u>Program</u>
 - HRA provides a 1 dwelling unit for program
