# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SOUTHEASTERN LIBRARIES COOPERATING

The undersigned President and Secretary of Southeastern Libraries Cooperating, for the purpose of restating and amending the Articles of Incorporation of Southeastern Libraries Cooperating, under and pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 317A, known as the Minnesota Non-Profit Corporation Act, do hereby establish a body corporate and adopt the following Restated and Amended Articles of Incorporation:

# ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation shall be Southeastern Libraries Cooperating.

# ARTICLE II. PURPOSE

The purpose of this corporation shall be:

- A. To institute various cooperative library practices and services jointly among the public libraries in Southeastern Minnesota:
- B. To coordinate the efforts of the member libraries toward attaining more adequate levels of service to the public;
- C. To qualify the member libraries for the benefits to be received from such state and federal aid funds for public library service as may become available to or through the cooperative organization; and
- D. To promote cooperation between public libraries and other types of libraries.

### ARTICLE III. PECUNIARY GAIN

This Corporation shall not afford pecuniary gain, incidentally or otherwise to its members.

### ARTICLE IV. DURATION

The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

### ARTICLE V. REGISTERED OFFICE

The location and post office address of the registered office of this corporation in Minnesota is located at 334 16th Street Southeast, Rochester, Minnesota 55904.

# ARTICLE VII. MANAGEMENT

- A. The management of this Corporation shall be vested in a Board of not less than ten (10) directors, the exact number to be stated in the By-Laws, who shall be elected as set forth in the By-Laws of the Corporation and for terms as set forth in such By-Laws.
- B. <u>Limitation on Liability</u>. No director of this Corporation shall be held civilly liable for an act or omission by the director if the act or omission was in good faith, was within the scope of the person's responsibilities as a director of the Corporation, and did not constitute willful or reckless misconduct, except for liability:

- 1. For an action or proceeding brought by the Attorney General for a breach of a fiduciary duty as a director;
- For a cause of action to the extent it is based on federal law;
- For a cause of action based on the person's express contractual obligations; or
- 4. For an action or proceeding based on a breach of public pension plan fiduciary responsibility.
- C. It is the intention of the members of this Corporation to eliminate or limit the personal liability of the directors of the Corporation to the greatest extent permitted under Minnesota law. If amendments to the Minnesota Statutes are passed after this section becomes effective which authorize non-profit corporations to act to further eliminate or limit the personal liability of directors, then the liability of the directors of this corporation shall be eliminated or limited to the greatest extent permitted by the Minnesota Statutes, as so amended.
- D. Any repeal or modification of this section by the members of this Corporation shall not adversely affect any right of or any protection available to a director of this Corporation which is in existence at the time of such repeal or modification.

The remaining assets shall be distributed to organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, or scientific purposes, which shall qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or as amended, or to an instrumentality of the federal, state, county, or city government.

THESE RESTATED ARTICLES SUPERSEDE ALL PREVIOUS ARTICLES AND AMENDMENTS.


