Civil Air Patrol Leave

Purpose To comply with Minnesota Statu<u>tes, Sectione</u> 181.946.

Policy Northfield recognizes the need for employees who are members of the Civil Air Patrol

to be able to respond to service requests from the State or any of its political

subdivisions.

Practices The City of Northfield will provide an unpaid leave, with normal benefits and no-

changes in seniority, to employees responding for time spent rendering services as a member of the civil air patrol to on the requests and under the authority of the State of Minnesota or any of its political subdivisions, provided that such leave would not

unduly disrupt the operations of the City.

Notification An employee requesting this leave will contact their immediate supervisor prior to

taking the leave. The supervisor will notify the Human Resources Director. The Human Resources Director and the direct supervisor together will grant or deny the

requested leave.

Verification An employee may be required to provide verification of the leave from the Civil Air

Patrol.
