





Opened for tours June 11th.

• Begins with land and first people before white settlement in the area



 Identifies local men, women, children, immigrants and minorities who were witnesses



• Threads a variety of voices throughout the exhibit and the days that followed – children, women, merchants, laborers, and immigrants



• Concludes reminding visitors of the bravery and sacrifice of the townspeople, not glorifying the Gang



City funding paid for lighting, handicapped accessibility, display cases, and vitrines.
