## CITY OF NORTHFIELD, MINNESOTA CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2020-073 2022-2023 MNDOT LOCAL PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM FUNDING APPLICATION APPROVAL

WHEREAS,	the Minnesota Department of Transportation State Aid for Local Transportation Office has solicited applications for funding of improvement to the Trunk Highways that benefit local communities through their Local Partnership Program (LPP); and,
WHEREAS,	the police department had a responding squad car crash at a signalized intersection on TH 3 related to motor vehicles not clearing the intersection in 2020; and,
WHEREAS,	the clearing intersections of vehicles along TH 3 at signalized intersection is greatly improved with the proposed Emergency Vehicle Preemption added to the traffic signals; and,
WHEREAS,	safety and response time for police, fire, ambulance emergency services will increase with Trunk Highway (TH) 3 traffic signal improvements; and,
WHEREAS,	improving the TH 3 traffic signals with flashing yellow arrows for left turns and new LED lights will allow for better flow of traffic in off-peak times and conversion to LED aligns with the City's Climate Action Plan and are eligible for LPP funding; and,
WHEREAS,	the City of Northfield will submit a LPP funding application requesting \$290,000 based upon the City's preliminary design estimate; and,
WHEREAS,	City Council supports and approves the submission of the MNDOT LPP funding application.
NOW, THER	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL THAT:
