## Notice of Regular Meeting of the Northfield City Council By Telephone / Electronic Means

Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 13D.021, subd. 1(1) I, Ben Martig, City Administrator of the City of Northfield, Minnesota, determine that in-person meetings of the Northfield City Council are not prudent during the COVID-19 health pandemic/peacetime emergency declared by the Governor's Executive Order No. 20-01 under Minn. Stat., Ch. 12. As such, the Northfield City Council regular meetings during such states of emergency, beginning with the regular meeting scheduled to occur at 6:00 pm on April 7, 2020 and continuing until further notice, will be held by telephone / other electronic means via GoTo Meeting and will be live streamed and any or all member(s) of the Northfield City Council may potentially attend such meeting by phone or other electronic means. A schedule of the Northfield City Council, regular meetings is available in the City Clerk's office.

Additionally, I determine the presence of the public at the regular meeting location is not feasible due to the COVID-19 health pandemic/emergency declaration, pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 13D.021, subd. 1(3).

Based in the foregoing, the City Council will hold a regular City Council meeting on September 1, 2020 at 6:00 pm via electronic means. Members of the public may monitor the September 1, 2020 meeting electronically from a remote location by dialing a conference number (United States: +1 (646) 749-3122) and entering a conference code (Access Code: 551-694-365); or by watching a live stream available on the City's website at:

<u>https://northfield.legistar.com/Calendar.aspx</u>. Members of the public monitoring by telephone will be asked to mute their phones.

Finally, I determine that the presence of at least one member of the body, chief legal counsel, or chief administrative officer at the regular meeting location is unfeasible due to the COVID-19 health pandemic/emergency declaration, pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 13D.021, subd. 1(4).

Once the City Council agenda is published, the eComment link will be active. eComment will be available until 4 pm on the day of the meeting during the pandemic. Comments will be limited to two minutes as is the normal practice and will be posted on the City's website with other meeting items following the meeting.
