Based in the foregoing, **the HRC will hold a regular meeting on September 10, 2020 at 6:00 pm via electronic means**. Members of the public may monitor the September 10, 2020 meeting electronically from a remote location by dialing a conference number (**United States: tel: +1 (571) 317-3122)** and entering a conference code (**Access Code: 936-553-509**). Members of the public monitoring by telephone will be asked to mute their phones.

Finally, I determine that the presence of at least one member of the body, chief legal counsel, or chief administrative officer at the regular meeting location is unfeasible due to the COVID-19 health pandemic/emergency declaration, pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 13D.021, subd. 1(4).
