Age-friendly communities have been called good places to grow up and grow older. They deliberately consider well-being of residents at every stage of life, especially older age, and recognize that cities have a big role in helping us fulfill the tremendous potential of aging. In 2016 the City of Northfield joined the World Health Organization and AARP Network of Age-Friendly Cities and Communities.

Northfield is well-positioned to take on the work of becoming an age-friendly city and already has many strengths as a community for older residents. More deliberate action must be taken now to ensure that the growing number of older adults have the housing, transportation, community information, services and other resources as needed to live engaged and independent lives.

Following a survey of 50+ Northfield Residents in 2017, data was analyzed and the 2020-2023 Action Plan was developed.
