

Guiding Implementation Report – Teresa Jensen

Public Art- Adam Turman is “paintbrush ready” to begin work on the Roundabout mural as soon as temperatures allow.

- John Sterner’s Eagle Sculpture—Natalie and Teresa have met John in a video conference 3/6 to discuss the next PARC meeting, which he will attend. A Doodle poll for PARC participants will go out on John’s availability, TBD.
- The 1% for the Arts Ordinance passed on consent 3/2/21 to City Council; it is now a part of the Ordinance 1022, which encompasses the former 855 Ordinance.
- Mural Policy--Natalie and Teresa have met with City Planner Mikayla Schmidt to discuss the correct placement of the mural policy within the city’s documents; we have had preliminary agreement that within the city’s Code of Ordinances, Chapter 34- Land Development Code/ Article 6-Signage is the right placement. To summarize, we would anticipate that the preliminary application for a mural would be made to the city planner, who would determine that it met the required physical parameters (type of building, size of mural, location within the public right of way, public or private property); if approved by the Planning office, it would go to the ACC for PARC review and approval. There is still much work to be done before we will be ready to bring to Council for approval.
