APPLICANT: DivoCSG 17 LLC

PURPOSE: Consider public input regarding a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) application from DivoCSG 17 LLC for a one mega-watt community solar garden.

LOCATION OF PROPERTY: PID 43-02700-50-030 in Dakota County. The site is located north of Highway 19/330th St. W. and west of Decker Ave.
