An eComment was received on this item. Melissa Hanson, Housing Coordinator, introduced the item and introduced Brad Scheib from HKGi. Mr. Scheib presented an overview of the Northfield Housing Study to include the purpose and background, housing trends and impacts, demographics inventory and analysis, housing inventory and analysis and housing demand and supply analysis/key findings. Hanson, Scheib and Jeff Miller, HKGi, answered questions from the Council.

Consider action and summary of conclusions of the evaluation of the performance of Ben Martig, City Administrator, pursuant to Minn. Stat. §13D.05, subd. 3.

Communications and Human Resources Director Mahowald introduced the item. Mayor Pownell reported on the City Administrator's performance review from the April 20, 2021 special meeting. Mr. Martig did not request that such meeting be open to the public. As a result, the evaluation of Mr. Martig's performance took place in a closed meeting as provided under the Minnesota Open Meeting Law.

Mayor Pownell provided a summary of the conclusions reached by the City Council from the April 20, 2021 evaluation: Northfield's elected officials and staff are extremely satisfied with their City Administrator's performance in the last year. Mr. Martig earned high praise for helping to keep the community safe and the City operating at peak performance throughout the pandemic. They have expressed, through this review process, a desire for him to continue on with this good work as their City Administrator for the upcoming year. City Administrator Martig is thanked for his dedicated service to the City of Northfield.
