

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING


NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the City of Northfield Heritage Preservation Commission will conduct a public hearing in the Council Chambers at Northfield City Hall, 801 Washington St., Northfield, MN, on Thursday, October 14, 2021, beginning on or after 4:00 p.m. to receive public input to consider a certificate of appropriateness for the demolition of the Archer House located at 212 Division Street South.
