Charlie Kite and Mar Valdecantos presented efforts to launch a local community marketplace at the Northfield Depot during winter months. They are working with Rice County Neighbors United to offer racial minority vendors and business owners access to a location to conduct business. Presenters answered members' questions and provided feedback on the initiative and advertising.

ED Coordinator Carlson presented the extent and slowing speed of facade improvement requests and then introduced two proposals: to extend the duration of the Facade Improvement Grant program, and to alter the program's district to include nearby buildings such as the Union of Youth building. That building, falling outside of the program's designated zone, was agreed to be ineligible under the program as it is. Carlson answered questions about the grant program and its scope. Members discussed the operations of the EDA, limitations of its programs, and options by which the EDA or another arm of City governance may handle the Union of Youth's request for financial support.

Member Ackerman made a motion, seconded by Member Strobel, to maintain the Facade Improvement Grant program as is. The motion carried with unanimous approval.

Member Ackerman made a motion, seconded by Member Strobel, to direct City staff to review the Union of Youth's petition, explore options for supporting the Union, and to determine the most appropriate response. The motion carried with unanimous approval.

A motion was made by Ackerman, seconded by Blazis, to extend the Facade Improvement Grant program until November 1, 2022. The motion carried by the following vote:
