Action Requested:

The Northfield City Council approves the attached Resolution formally accepting Presidential Nomination Primary Reimbursement from the Minnesota Secretary of State Office.

Summary Report:

The City Council is being asked to officially accept the Presidential Nomination Primary Reimbursement from the Minnesota Secretary of State Office of \$22,267.70 received June 24,2024.

According to Minnesota Statute 207A.15 Subdivision 2, the Secretary of State must reimburse the counties and municipalities for expenses incurred in the administration of the presidential nomination primary from money contained in the presidential nomination primary elections account.
