### **Action Requested:**

The Northfield City Council is being asked to hold a public hearing for On-sale Intoxicating and Sunday Liquor Licenses for 5<sup>th</sup> & Division Street Partners LLC, dba Reunion, located at 501-505 Division Str. S., Northfield.

#### **Summary Report:**

5<sup>th</sup> & Division Street Partners LLC, dba Reunion, has applied for On-sale Intoxicating and Sunday Liquor Licenses for 501-505 Division Str. S., Northfield.
