Summary Report:

In order for the HRC Commissioners and staff to make the best use of meeting and outside meeting time spent on HRC items, the HRC will develop a more intentional work plan for 2022. The City is also asking all Boards & Commissions to align their work, as much as possible, with the 2021-2024 Strategic Plan. - 2. Of these topics, are there any you would be willing to lead? If so, how? For example: convene a work
