Action Requested:

The Northfield City Council holds a continued public hearing on assessments for 2020 Mill and Overlay Project (2020STRT-A45) - Carleton College properties proposed assessments.

Summary Report:

Process for Continued Assessment Hearing

- 2. Take City staff presentation related to Carleton College properties assessments.
- 3. Take public testimony on the Carleton College objections as you typically would in a public hearing (testimony limited to Carleton College properties assessments).
- 4. Council questions of staff/discussion related to Carleton College properties assessments.
- 5. Close the continued public hearing.
- 6. Move to next council agenda item to consider for adoption Resolution passing upon objections to Carleton College's assessments:

On May 14, 2020, Carleton College submitted a letter of objection to the City Clerk, City Council, Engineering Department, and Administration, objecting to their assessment amount of \$397,765. City Council held a public hearing regarding the 2020 Mill and Overlay Project (2020STRT-A45) at their May 19, 2020 City Council Meeting. At the meeting, the public hearing was closed for all properties with the exception of Carleton College properties.

Carleton College submitted their requested changes to their assessment to the City on May 27, 2020.

Alternative Options:

City Council could pass a motion to <u>continue</u> the public hearing to June 16, 2020 if additional time is needed for review.
