Consideration of a Stormwater Maintenance Agreement with Hometown Federal Credit Union.

Action Requested:

The Northfield City Council approves a <u>Motion</u> authorizing the City to enter into a required Maintenance Agreement and Maintenance Plan with Hometown Federal Credit Union for private stormwater management facilities at the Hometown Credit Union.

Summary Report:

Hometown Federal Credit Union is constructing a new credit union on an undeveloped vacant property. As part of the project, in order to meet stormwater management requirements, a private on-site stormwater facility is proposed for construction.

According to Northfield City Code, Chapter 22 - Environment, stormwater treatment is required to treat the additional stormwater generated from the added impervious surface on the site. Kim Westphal, President and CEO of Hometown Federal Credit Union, signed and approved the agreement on September 11, 2020 and is now ready for the City to execute the agreement.

The City of Northfield Ordinance Section 22-306 requires the execution of a Maintenance Agreement (Attachment 1) with the City of Northfield to ensure proper inspections and maintenance are performed on the proposed stormwater management facility. This agreement also grants the City of Northfield and its representatives right of entry for the purpose of inspecting the proposed strormwater management facility, and performing any maintenance on the stormwater management facility should the owner fail to perform required maintenance detailed in the Maintenance Agreement.
